GRANTS

- **Montour County Commissioners' 2016 Tourism Fund grants (no change since last meeting)**
 - \$10,000 granted on 1/26/16 for 2016 River Towns Race Series advertising / promotion
 - As of 6/12/16, all funds have been expended
 - \$5,000 granted on 1/26/16 for 2016 Montour Preserve operation
 - Per PA County Code Hotel Tax legislation, these funds must be used to promote the Montour Preserve as a tourism destination

- **Williams Transco Pipeline Atlantic Sunrise Project / The Conservation Fund Environmental Stewardship Program (no change since last meeting)**
 - \$146,000 granted to Susquehanna Greenway Partnership (SGP) on 10/1/15
 - SGP to administer grant, assist with sign design and planning and assist MARC with project implementation; SGP retains \$7,500
 - MARC may be reimbursed a total of \$138,500 in eligible grant expenses incurred between 10/1/15 and 9/30/16
 - MARC has so far been reimbursed \$79,628.27 in North Branch Canal Trail expenses incurred 9/1/15 – 6/23/16
 - MARC will submit one final request for reimbursement of \$58,871.73 in eligible project expenses incurred 6/24/16 – 9/30/16 (grant closeout)
 - **NOTE:** MARC must reimburse to Montour County \$114,421 (plus interest as applicable) in funding provided by the county to MARC for up-front funding of project expenses while MARC awaited grant reimbursement

MANAGED SITES

- **East Branch Recreation Area**
 - \$2,430.66 remains earmarked in our account for site supplies
 - \$5,188.76 remains earmarked in our account for site maintenance through 4/30/17
 - Site maintenance has been uneventful this year; usage has been relatively light

- **River Drive parcel (North Branch Canal Trail trailhead and river access) (no change since last meeting)**
 - Additional site enhancements will be done in coming months as schedule and funding permits

- **Hopewell Park / Danville Borough Farm (no change since last meeting)**
 - Notices have been posted at the trailhead and online reminding site users of Saturday trail closures during the October – December hunting seasons; trails will be closed Mondays – Saturdays from November 28 – December 10 during the firearms deer season
 - Trail maintenance and upgrades are ongoing thanks to volunteer efforts
 - Stoudt, Decoteau and Bowie are considering updates to trailhead kiosk signage, brochures and trail signs; upgrades will be made as funding allows

MANAGED SITES (continued)

- **Hess Recreation Area**
 - Skatepark (**no change since last meeting**)
 - Concrete cracks need to be sealed before they become worse
 - Ballfields (**no change since last meeting**)
 - Despite infield work done in April, the softball field remains in relatively poor condition; a significant investment of time and effort is needed to restore the field to good condition
 - Road
 - Danville Borough Street Department staff patched several potholes during the week of 10/31 – 11/4
 - MARC has requested that Danville Borough assist with pothole repair / chip and tar surfacing of the park entrance road in 2017; Stoudt has contacted R.C. Young for a rough estimate of possible costs, but no information yet received

- **Montour Township (Columbia County) parcel (no change since last meeting)**
 - MARC is responsible for mowing / maintenance of this parcel in return for permission to use the site for material staging and access to the North Branch Canal Trail
 - MARC's mowing contractor continues to mow the site as needed
 - No concerns have been noted

- **Montour Preserve**
 - Goose Cove and Heron Cove restroom sewage pumping done 10/21
 - Goose Cove and Heron Cove picnic areas and water systems were winterized on 11/1; water testing suspended through April 2017
 - Boat dock and fishing pier moved to winter storage on 11/2
 - Preserve Environmental Education Center auditorium used as Anthony Twp. polling place on 11/7
 - Montour County/MARC will receive \$200,000 in funding from the Commonwealth of PA for Montour Preserve operation and maintenance; funding has not yet been received and specific grant details remain unknown at this time

DIRECTOR'S REPORT (continued)

MANAGED SITES (continued)

- **North Branch Canal Trail**

- Trail miles 0.0 through 3.5 remain open to the public; usage has been consistent, particularly on weekends
 - An adjacent landowner in Montour County is upset by trail usage during hunting seasons and has requested the trail be closed to all users during all hunting seasons (October 1 – January 14, 2017 and April 22, 2017 – May 31, 2017)
 - Stoudt has instituted trail closures during the Special Antlered Deer Youth Firearms Season on October 21 & 22 and plans a closure during the Regular Antlered and Antlerless Deer Firearms Season on November 28 – December 10 (excluding Sunday, December 4), but is not inclined to enforce closures during other seasons
 - Stoudt has encouraged the landowner to bring his concerns to MARC's Board and/or the Montour County Commissioners for their consideration if so desired
- Trail miles 3.5 – 3.9 remain closed due to adjacent landowner conflict, pending guidance from Montour County
- Trail miles 3.9 – 6.2 in Columbia County remain closed until land transfer is complete
- MARC is grateful for the significant volunteer assistance of Columbia County resident Wayne Kashner for his ongoing trash cleanup along the trail corridor, particularly near the Catawissa Boat Club (see photos below)

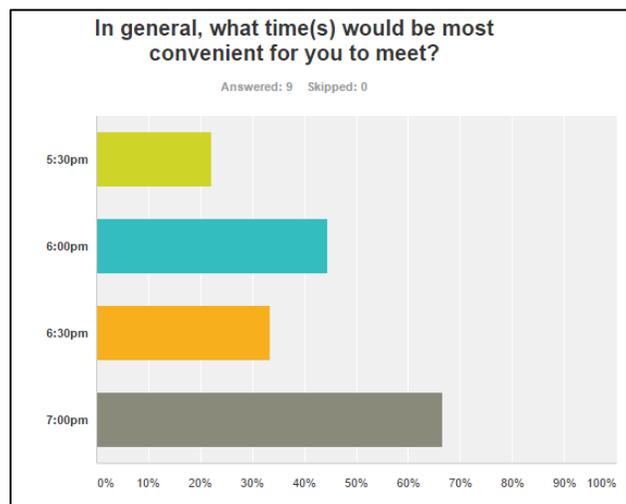
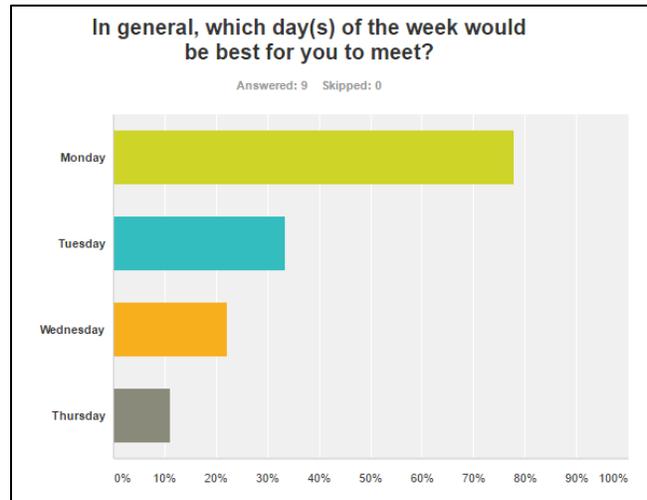
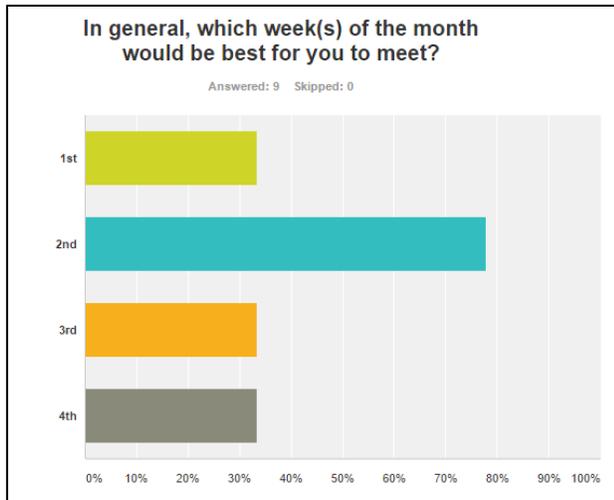
PROPOSED MARC 2017 BUDGET EXPENSES (\$203,400)
