



MARC TOTAL ASSETS AS OF 6/15/2020





GRANTS

- **DCED Marketing to Attract Tourists Grant (Montour Preserve)**
 - As of 6/19/2020, \$710.30 in interest earned on grant funds remains earmarked in MARC's DCED grant checking account
 - Per the grant terms, these funds must be reimbursed to DCED at the time of grant closeout
 - Stoudt has been in communication with McKonly & Asbury (formerly Brewer & Company, LLC) regarding how best to proceed with the required performance audit
 - Stoudt will scan all grant receipts and supporting materials and provide them electronically to the auditors for review
 - It is anticipated that the grant audit will be complete and the final grant closeout paperwork submitted to DCED within 30 days

- **Montour County 2020 Hotel Tax**
 - MARC on 5/15/2020 received \$20,824.24 for the Q1 2020 (January – March) period
 - Funds were deposited to MARC's savings account
 - Stoudt will consult with McKonly & Asbury (formerly Brewer & Co.) to determine how best to comply with grant auditing requirements
 - MARC on 6/19/2020 received a second payment of \$233.72 for the Q1 2020 period from revenues generated by payments received by Montour County after the initial payment was released
 - As of 6/19/2020, Stoudt and CMVB staff continue to project that MARC may receive approximately \$37,500 in Montour County Hotel Tax funding in 2020 (\$21,057.96 of which has already been received)
 - MARC had anticipated approximately \$160,000 per year in funding under average conditions and had initially budgeted for \$100,000 for 2020
 - MARC's revised budget, adopted 5/18/2020, has been reduced to take into account this anticipated reduction in income
 - Stoudt is scheduled to participate in the CMVB's 6/24/2020 Executive Committee Zoom meeting to provide an update as required by the terms of the CMVB/MARC/Montour County MOU governing the use of Montour County Hotel Tax funds

- **Montour County COVID-19 County Relief Block Grant**
 - Montour County has been advised that it is eligible to receive up to approximately \$1.65 million in funding through the PA Department of Community and Economic Development's (DCED) COVID-19 County Block Grant program (<https://dced.pa.gov/programs/covid-19-county-relief-block-grant-program/>), using funds provided by the federal government to the Commonwealth of PA
 - As an entity primarily engaged in the tourism industry, MARC may be eligible to receive a portion of this funding
 - Montour County applied for funding on 6/16/2020 and anticipates receiving funding by mid-July
 - It is unknown at this time what funding, if any, MARC may receive, but the Montour County Commissioners have stated their desire to assist MARC if possible
 - It is believed that funding, if received, must be spent by 12/30/2020, but additional clarification on this point is being sought

- **CSCF Women's Giving Circle 2020**
 - MARC applied on 1/30/2020 for \$750 in grant funding to support the 2020 Girls ROC Mountain Bike Camp
 - MARC was notified on 2/27/2020 that it had been awarded \$500
 - MARC received the check on 3/19/2020 and deposited the funds to MARC's checking account, earmarked for the 2020 Girls ROC Mountain Bike Camp
 - Event organizers have rescheduled the event to June 15 – 24 and Stoudt has been in communication with organizers regarding participant waivers, accounting, and eligible expenses

- **CSCF Danville Area School District Youth in Philanthropy**
 - MARC on 3/4/2020 submitted a letter of interest for grant support for the Washingtonville DeLong Park swing set project (\$1,500 requested) and the Hopewell Park pump track design (\$1,500)
 - MARC on 5/11/2020 received a check for \$600
 - Stoudt deposited the check to MARC's checking account, allocated as \$300 for the Washingtonville DeLong Park swing set project and \$300 for the Hopewell Park pump track
 - The Washingtonville Revitalization Committee has selected a swing set for purchase and Stoudt will present the invoice for approval during this meeting
 - Stoudt has been in contact with DirtSculpt and anticipates scheduling a public site visit to Hopewell Park in July to begin the pump track design process

MANAGED SITES

- **Hopewell Park / Danville Borough Farm**
 - Stoudt has been in contact with DirtSculpt and anticipates scheduling a public meeting / site visit in July to begin the pump track design process
 - MARC's 5/18/2020 revised budget continues to earmark \$5,000 for this project as originally planned
 - Stoudt has been in contact with the Montour County Conservation District and Mahoning Township's Zoning Office to discuss permitting requirements for the planned parking lot improvement project
 - No new permits will be required; work will be conducted under MARC's previously secured Erosion and Sedimentation permit for the site
 - Stoudt has been in contact with Dave Decoteau and Elijah Evans to schedule the work to begin as soon as their schedules allow

- **Montour Township (Columbia County) Legion Road parcel**
 - Trail Steward Wayne Kashner has continued to clean up trash and debris from the site to allow for easier mowing and care of the property

• North Branch Canal Trail

- Stoudt and son Ben on 5/21/2020 hiked the Montour County portion of the trail between mile markers 0.0 and 3.6 to perform trail maintenance and tree clearing as needed, as well as a drone inspection of sections of the trail subject to river erosion
 - No new areas of erosion concern were noted, but Stoudt and Trail Steward Wayne Kashner will continue to monitor known areas of concern
- Stoudt and son Ben on 6/17/2020 hiked the Columbia County portion of the trail along the Catawissa Boat Club to perform minor trail clearing and reinstalled the trail mile markers 6.0, 6.1, and 6.2 which had been knocked out of place in 2019 flooding
- New trail encroachments have been noted in the Bear Hunters' Campground (trail miles 3.65 – 3.95)
 - Stoudt will attempt to resolve the issues in coming days to allow the trail to pass unobstructed through the campground

• Montour Preserve

- As of 5/30/2020, all facilities at the Montour Preserve are reopened to public use, though occupancy restrictions are being enforced for the visitors' center (10-person maximum occupancy) and all pavilions (50% normal capacity)
 - Restroom sanitation precautions continue to be enforced at all Preserve restrooms
- Black bear sightings continue to be reported around the site
 - Bears on 6/12/2020 destroyed several bird feeders in the visitors' center bird feeding area
 - Feeders have been removed and will not be replaced until sightings become less frequent
 - Bear warning signs continue to be posted at all trailheads and other locations around the site
- Volunteers from the Master Gardener program have continued to improve the herb/pollinator garden near the visitors' center
- Volunteers from the PA Master Naturalist program have been working to rehabilitate the butterfly wall along the Wildlife Management Trail
- Volunteer Doug Fought has been working to rehabilitate and improve the pond / waterfall feature in the visitors' center bird watching area
- Jon Beam has been working to rehabilitate the microphone / speaker system in the visitors' center bird watching area
- The Goose Cove and Heron Cove pavilion water systems were turned on for the season on 6/11/2020 after water testing reports were finally received
 - Water fountain fixtures have been removed at the pavilions as COVID-19 precautions; only water spigots remain
- Though all in-person programming remains suspended until further notice, Jon Beam has continued working to create a weekly series of 'Nature Notes' programs, posted to MARC's Facebook page and the Montour Preserve website at <https://montourpreserve.org/nature-notes/>
- Jon Beam has created new signage for the Planet Walk trail and has completed a corresponding podcast; signage will be fabricated and installed as soon as possible
- The HVAC unit in the visitors' center is experiencing problems and is under repair; repairs are covered under warranty
- Sewage pumping of the Goose Cove and Heron Cove restrooms was completed on 6/15/2020

MANAGED SITES (continued)

- **River Drive parcel (North Branch Canal Trail trailhead and river access)**
 - Stoudt and son Ben on 6/17/2020 performed maintenance on the boat launch area and around the main entrance sign
 - Additional maintenance work is planned in coming days

- **Hess Recreation Area**
 - Usage of the site has been steadily increasing since Montour County was designated as “Phase Green”
 - The Danville Lady Rainers organization continues to make improvements to the two softball fields and related amenities
 - Stoudt and a community service volunteer on 6/7/2020 installed new safety precautions along the Robbins Trail in the area slowly slumping toward Mahoning Creek
 - Stoudt and volunteers continue to regularly monitor the site
 - Repairs will be required to the wooden decking of the powerline observation area along the Robbins Trail
 - Stoudt and volunteers will replace failed boards in coming days

SPECIAL PROJECTS AND EVENTS

- **Riverside Borough River Access**
 - Stoudt and son Ben on 6/17/2020 visited the site to clear encroaching vegetation and perform minor maintenance
 - during the site visit, it was discovered that the large sign hung above the access road had gone missing
 - It appears the sign hanging hardware wore through the sign and it fell in mid- to late-March (per photos provided by Bill Lavage)
 - Stoudt has contacted the Riverside Borough Streets Department and others to try to locate the sign, but as of 6/19/2020, it has not been located
 - Stoudt will re-hang the sign if it can be found or will seek to fabricate and install a new sign when funding allows

- **Danville Borough Montgomery Park River Access**
 - Stoudt visited the site on 6/17/2020 to inspect signage and perform minor maintenance as needed
 - Danville Borough staff continue to do an excellent job of maintaining the site for public access
 - Only one sign required minor adjustment

- **Columbia County Projects**
 - No updates since last meeting

- **Danville / Montour County Bike / Pedestrian Safety**
 - Stoudt participated in the 5/28/2020 Middle Susquehanna Active Transportation Committee meeting

- **Mountain Biking Special Projects**
 - Stoudt anticipates scheduling an online meeting of MARC's Mountain Biking Advocacy Group (MBAG) in late June

- **Health & Wellness Special Projects**
 - Stoudt and son Ben have worked with Geisinger, the Northcentral Pennsylvania Conservancy, Montour County Conservation District, PA Fish & Boat Commission, and other partners to provide drone imagery of the recently completed Sechler Run habitat improvement project at Geisinger's Woodbine Lane facility

- **Races**
 - All remaining MARC 2020 races have been cancelled; no new events are planned until COVID-19 restrictions allow for a viable event

- **Washingtonville Revitalization**
 - As noted on page 24 of this report, the Washingtonville Revitalization Committee has selected a swing set for purchase and Stoudt will present the invoice for approval during this meeting
 - The purchase will be paid using a portion of the \$5,000 Central Susquehanna Valley Board of Realtors' grant, as well as the \$300 Youth in Philanthropy grant and donations as needed
 - Stoudt and Mayor Tyler Dombroski have met with a landowner adjacent to Chillisquaque Creek to identify and possibly secure a stream access easement (no update since last meeting)
 - edits will be made to the proposed easement agreement to satisfy landowner concerns
 - if approved by the landowner, Stoudt will present to MARC's Board for consideration
 - follow-up conversations will be scheduled in coming weeks with additional landowners (subject to COVID-19 travel and meeting restrictions)
 - Stoudt continues to work with volunteers to identify, map, and promote bicycling routes in the Washingtonville area (no update since last meeting)
 - Work is proceeding slowly because of COVID-19 restrictions

- **Tourism Promotion Special Projects**
 - The Danville Heritage Festival Committee intends to promote online educational resources, rather than in-person events, for the planned 7/13 - 7/18/2020 event
 - Stoudt and representatives of the Columbia-Montour Visitors Bureau are working to finalize the mapping of all parks, trails, and outdoor recreational sites in and around Montour County (no update since last meeting)
 - draft mapping was released on 3/17 as part of MARC's COVID-19 response
 - improvements and upgrades will be made in coming weeks as conditions allow
 - Stoudt has been contacted by organizers of a possible new mountain biking event to be hosted in the Danville area in 2021
 - planning is in the earliest stages and no details are yet available

OTHER UPDATES

- **Riverside Borough Park Improvements**

- Stoudt continues working with the Borough of Riverside to discuss possible changes and improvements to park offerings in the Borough of Riverside
- Riverside Borough, in cooperation with the Northumberland County Planning Office, are exploring grant opportunities to help fund improvements
 - MARC will assist where possible to implement improvements and handicapped-accessibility upgrades

- **Navigable Waters**

- Stoudt continues consulting with regional organizations to determine how best to respond to recent developments regarding a legal challenge to the navigability of Fishing Creek in Columbia County
- Stoudt will serve on a planned Columbia-Montour Visitors Bureau Taskforce related to the issue
 - The group's initial meeting is anticipated in coming days

- **Montour and Columbia Counties Park, Trail, and Outdoor Recreation Mapping**

- Stoudt has released draft mapping of park, trail, and outdoor recreation features in Montour and Columbia Counties on MARC's website at <https://montourec.com/parks-trails-in-montour-county/> and <https://montourec.com/fish-and-boat-in-montour-and-columbia-counties-pa/>
- Enhancements and additions to the mapping will be completed in coming weeks

- **MARC 2020 Budget Update**

- Stoudt has submitted no more than 25 hours per week since MARC's revised budget was adopted on 5/18/2020
- The volume of Montour Preserve pavilion reservations has increased significantly since Montour County was designated as "Phase Green", but it is too soon to determine whether it will have a significant positive budget impact
- The volume of Montour Preserve donations has increased slightly in recent weeks, but it is again too soon to determine whether it will have a significant positive budget impact
- The Montour County COVID-19 County Relief Block Grant program has the greatest potential to dramatically improve MARC's 2020 budget outlook
 - MARC will likely know by mid-July if funding will become available
