- MARC on 12/13/21 was awarded \$25,000 in American Rescue Act grant funding from Mahoning Township
- Funds are to be used to offset the negative economic impact of COVID-19 on MARC's operations and to be focused on projects of importance to Mahoning Township residents
- o MARC on 12/30/21 expended \$9,305 to pay Kleinfelder for engineering work for the Hess Loop Trail (J. Manley Robbins Trail) at the Hess Recreation Area
- \$15,806.74 (with earned interest) remains earmarked in a dedicated checking account to pay a
 portion of the costs for the planned engineering, permitting, and design work for the Hopewell Park

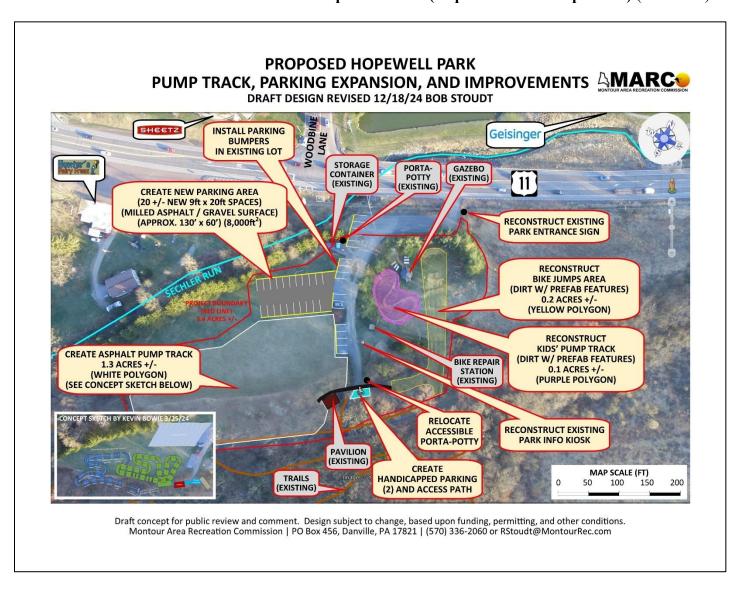
- o MARC was notified on 12/30/21 that its application to DCNR for \$125,000 in grant funding to rehabilitate Hopewell Park had been conditionally approved
 - Project activities will include expanding and improving parking, improving site drainage, creating bicycle skills features, reconstructing the existing earthen beginner-level pump track and jumps area, creating a new asphalt-paved pump track, and adding new universallyaccessible parking and access features
- As authorized by MARC's Board, all necessary documentation has been provided to DCNR to allow the redesignation of grant funds from MARC to Montour County to satisfy DCNR's requirements
 - An updated grant agreement has been provided to Montour County, allowing work to proceed once final documentation is in place
- O Stoudt continues to remain in contact with project stakeholders, engineers, and representatives of the American Ramp Company to finalize the tasks needed to allow the project to move forward
- o Work began at Hopewell Park on 6/16/25 for construction access to the nearby Moore Energy solar energy facility and will continue, weather permitting, for several days in the next several weeks
 - Work will include reconstruction of the park's access road and an expansion of the park's parking area.
 - MARC, Moore Energy, and project contractors are working to coordinate construction activities to minimize unnecessary delays for both projects while protecting park resources and visitor safety.
 - The trails on the Danville Borough Farm portion of the Hopewell Park / Danville Borough Farm Trail System will remain open to use during this construction, but parking at the Toby Run Road access is extremely limited.
- o Barring unexpected permitting or other delays, MARC anticipates construction of the pump track will occur in late summer to early fall.
- o All work must be completed, including grant closeout, by 12/31/25. If MARC anticipates work will not be completed in time, MARC may request an extension through DCNR.

• Hess Recreation Area

- o MARC on 4/8/25 discovered the toilets in the Hess restrooms were not flushing properly and found an alarm to be sounding on the outside rear of the building.
 - MARC's staff believed the problem to be related to the sewage line, so MARC contacted Starr Portables to make a service call to help empty or flush the tank.
 - MARC and Starr Portables found the problem to be with the pumps that pull the waste from the building and send it into the sewer line. At the advice of Starr Portables, MARC contacted Chip Adams Sewer and Drain to make the repair.
 - Chip Adams found that both of the pumps for the building were burned out and in need of replacement. The restrooms were immediately closed to all use.
 - Chip Adams called in the company that services the brand of pumps and they found the pumps to be original to the building probably more than 20 years old and no longer serviceable. As a result, MARC had no choice but to replace both of the pumps at a cost of \$9,921 (invoice to be presented during this meeting for payment).
- o Invitation to bid documentation is now available through Danville Borough for the planned final phase of the resurfacing of the roadway with Driving Surface Aggregate
 - Work will include regrading of the existing roadway, placement of geotextile fabric along the road's length, and placement of Driving Surface Aggregate
 - Construction must be completed before September 30
 - Project funding is provided by the Montour County Conservation District's Dirt, Gravel, and Low-Volume Road grant program
 - More information about the program is available at https://dirtandgravel.psu.edu/general-resources/driving-surface-aggregate-dsa/
- o No significant changes to trail conditions have been noted by MARC's staff or volunteers in recent weeks, despite continued exceedingly wet conditions
 - MARC's staff will work in coming months to repair several minor drainage issues, allowing easier access by contractors for future work
- o MARC continues to clear downed trees and other issues on a regular basis
- One road culvert pipe remains significantly blocked from repeated storm erosion; Stoudt has reached out to Danville area contacts for assistance (no change since last meeting; work must wait until volunteer schedules allow)
- o SEDA-COG on 9/30/24 installed two trail counters at the Beaver Place trailhead and near the park entrance trailhead to record trail usage for one year
 - A SEDA-COG Metropolitan Planning Organization-created story map of regional trail demand patterns is available at https://storymaps.arcgis.com/stories/b55ba5dda05440928c763dcf248e14ab
 - Data from the trail counters at Hopewell Park and the Hess Loop Trail will be added to the story map in coming months as information becomes available



MANAGED SITES (continued)

- Hess Recreation Area (continued)
 - o MARC on 4/25/25 and 4/26/25 worked with volunteers from GTI and others to do litter cleanups throughout the park



- MARC has been awarded \$1,000 in grant funds from the Susquehanna Greenway Partnership's Mini-Grant program to allow the fabrication and installation of a new J. Manley Robbins Trail interpretive sign for installation at the Beaver Place Trailhead
 - Stoudt's proposed sign design has been approved by the Susquehanna Greenway Partnership and Stoudt is now working to have the sign fabricated before MARC's staff can do the installation



MANAGED SITES (continued)

- Hess Recreation Area (continued)
- During preparations for the PICL Coaches' Retreat, held 5/2 5/4/25, MARC's staff worked on 5/2/25 to clear storm damages around the Mahoning Flats Trail network
 - While clearing downed trees with a chainsaw, Stoudt was advised by a park visitor that one of the trees Stoudt had previously cleared was smoldering and appeared likely to catch fire (conditions were very dry on 5/2, before the rainy conditions set in)
 - o Stoudt and the park visitor found the tree to have caught fire and Stoudt worked with the fire extinguisher in his truck to extinguish the flames, only to find the fire rekindle
 - o Stoudt and Brehm worked with the extinguisher in MARC's truck, but the fire again rekindled
 - Stoudt called for assistance and units from East End and Continental Fire Companies responded to extinguish the blaze
 - The fire was kept to an area not larger than 10ft x 20ft, but MARC thanks the stations for preventing what could have become a serious situation
 - o It is not clear what sparked the blaze, but Stoudt suspects a spark may have been caused by the chainsaw chain hitting a stone while Stoudt was cutting
 - o MARC staff are investigating the purchase of water-based extinguishers that can be carried in the field during future dry condition work days







MANAGED SITES (continued)

• Hopewell Park / Danville Borough Farm Trail System

- As noted earlier in this report, work began on 6/16/25 for construction access to the nearby Moore Energy solar facility and will continue, weather permitting, for several days in the next several weeks
 - Work will include reconstruction of the park's access road and an expansion of the park's parking area.
 - MARC, Moore Energy, and project contractors are working to coordinate construction activities to minimize unnecessary delays for both projects while protecting park resources and visitor safety.
 - The trails on the Danville Borough Farm portion of the Hopewell Park / Danville Borough Farm Trail System will remain open to use during this construction, but parking at the Toby Run Road access is extremely limited.
- Stoudt remains engaged with Danville Borough regarding the ongoing discussion of forest management planning at the Danville Borough Farm and other Borough-owned properties and has assisted with mapping of Danville Borough-owned properties and forested areas
 - Stoudt anticipates discussions will continue through 2025
- o The Danville Borough Farm Land / Facility Use Memorandum of Understanding between the Borough of Danville and MARC is set to expire in October 2025
 - Danville Borough Council on 1/15/25 began discussion of the agreement and recommended Borough staff prepare updates for Council's consideration at upcoming meetings
 - Stoudt has attended several Danville Borough Council and Committee meetings in recent months and anticipates the agreement will go before Danville Borough Council on July 8
 - If approved by Danville Borough Council in July, Stoudt will present the updated agreement for MARC's adoption at MARC's August 25 meeting (see pages 49 54 of this document for the current draft version of the agreement)
- o SEDA-COG on 9/30/24 installed a trail counter at the trailhead to record trail usage for one year
 - A SEDA-COG Metropolitan Planning Organization-created story map of regional trail demand patterns is available at https://storymaps.arcgis.com/stories/b55ba5dda05440928c763dcf248e14ab
 - Data from the trail counters at Hopewell Park and the Hess Loop Trail will be added to the story map in coming months as information becomes available



MANAGED SITES (continued)

Mill Park Natural Area

- MARC staff in April and May completed several tasks at the site, including expansion of the parking area, installation of the new interpretive signage kiosk, mowing and establishment of a 0.25 milelong walking path and stream access, vegetation pruning, litter cleanup, and installation of a picnic table
- o MARC staff also installed a trail camera at the site to monitor for vandalism
- o MARC assisted Washingtonville Borough and Montour County officials on 5/24/25 for the dedication and opening of the site to public use
- o Stoudt will create a page on MARC's website to provide information about the site
- o Per the site's deed restrictions related to flood mitigation, MARC may not place any permanent structures on the site; it must be maintained in a natural condition







MANAGED SITES (continued)

Montour Preserve

- Lake Chillisquaque reopened to boating on May 1
 - The Riverside Adventure Company resumed Kayak Kiosk operation on this same date
 - Weather conditions year-to-date have resulted in limited usage
- o MARC continues to coordinate with the Middle Susquehanna Riverkeeper Association's Vernal School to prioritize maintenance needs and 2025 funding priorities at the Montour Preserve
 - Work is ongoing to finalize repairs to the Muskrat Blind
 - The blind remains closed to all use until repairs are complete
 - Work has begun to repair and re-seal parking lots and roadways
- o MARC has requested a quote from Johnson Controls to update the visitors' center fire alarm system
- o The Environmental Education Center's refrigerator failed in early June and had to be replaced
- o The HVAC unit serving the auditorium continues to have issues and had to be repaired again in early June
- Attendance by school groups in May far exceeded previous years, due in large part to programming offered by the Vernal School partnership
- o MARC has partnered with the PA Game Commission to install new chimney swift and purple martin nesting structures near the Heron Cove Picnic Area



- Montour Township (Columbia County) Legion Road parcel (no updates since last meeting)
 - MARC staff and Trail Stewards will continue to monitor for trespassing concerns on the adjacent North Shore Railroad

• MANAGED SITES (continued)

• North Branch Canal Trail

- o MARC staff on 6/5 and 6/12/25 repaired the failed culvert pipe between trail miles 1.3 − 1.4, following guidance provided by the Montour County Conservation District and PA DEP officials to protect wetlands located upstream and downstream of the pipe
 - MARC staff on 6/5/25 were confronted by an adjacent landowner with complaints of excessive water passing through the location, causing excessively wet conditions on adjacent fields
 - the landowner demanded MARC remove the pipe or face legal action
 - Stoudt has advised Montour County, MARC's Solicitor, the Montour County Conservation District, PA DEP, and Mahoning Township regarding the complaint
 - MARC on 6/12/25 discovered that a custom-made wooden plug was placed inside the culvert pipe, blocking 95+% of the flow
 - o MARC staff removed the plug and are monitoring the site on a regular basis





- O Stoudt has consulted with the Montour County Conservation District regarding the ford crossing at mile marker 2.7 which has been repeatedly destroyed by heavy rains
 - It is recommended that MARC rebuild the crossing with R6 rock and a log cross-vane to provide better long-term stability for the crossing
 - MARC will investigate costs and schedule the work when funding and staff availability allow
- O Stoudt and Wayne Kashner on 1/18/23 met with a representative of the Columbia County Conservation District to determine permitting requirements to install a new culvert at trail mile 5.4 (culvert was permitted under NPDES permit, but not installed)
 - Stoudt has received the necessary guidance for the permitting
 - Stoudt and Brehm will complete and submit the permit application and required fees as time and funding allow
 - Work must be completed as soon as possible to address ongoing challenges for MARC's lawn care contractor
 - Funding for this project will be provided by Columbia County, as authorized by the recently renewed Memorandum of Understanding
- Montour County continues legal action against the owner of the Bear Hunters' Grove Campground to resolve the years-long property ownership dispute
 - Stoudt anticipates legal proceedings will be ongoing through the summer
 - MARC will continue to enforce the trail closure through the disputed lands between trail miles 3.5-4.2; no MARC staff or volunteers will enter the disputed lands until the matter is resolved



MANAGED SITES (continued)

- North Branch Canal Trail trailhead and river access (River Drive parcel)
 - Stoudt continues to monitor ongoing property encroachments by an adjacent landowner and has notified Montour County officials
 - MARC staff have identified new encroachments placed since the beginning of the year
 - Stoudt hopes to hire a surveyor to relocate and re-mark property corner markers which have been removed



- The main site sign frame needs to be replaced; work will proceed as time allows
- O Stoudt has been advised that site visitors are confused with how to access the North Branch Canal Trail from the site
 - Stoudt will create new signage to be posted at the site directing visitors to the trail

- Stoudt continues to serve on the SEDA-COG Metropolitan Planning Organization Committee on behalf of Montour County and Multi-Modal Transportation interests

• Bicycle Routes Mapping and Promotion (no updates since last meeting)

- MARC is working with the Columbia Montour Visitors Bureau and the Susquehanna River Valley Visitors Bureau to promote bicycling route mapping and online distribution through the RideWithGPS platform (www.RideWithGPS.com)
 - MARC has completed the mapping, driving, and photographing of several bicycling routes around Montour County as identified by volunteers Kit Kelly, Dr. Victor Marks, and others
 - Julian Brehm has completed the final quality assurance on the routes and is preparing a new rack card for publication
 - Stoudt will create a new page on MARC's website for distribution of the content
 - Project release is anticipated in 2025

• Chilli Challenge Adventure Triathlon (no update since last meeting)

o Event will not be held in 2024

• Chillisquaque Creek Cleanup and Promotion (no update since last meeting)

- MARC staff will work with Washingtonville Borough and other partners to conduct litter cleanup and log jam removal efforts along the Chillisquaque Creek in 2025 when conditions allow
 - MARC will consult with the Montour County Conservation District, DEP, and other agencies to determine best practices and permitting requirements for log jam clearing

DANVILLE BOROUGH FARM LAND / FACILITY USE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

BOROUGH OF DANVILLE

AND

MONTOUR AREA RECREATION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Borough of Danville (hereinafter the Borough) owns and operates certain agricultural and forested lands and structures in the Borough of Danville and Mahoning Township, Montour County, PA in the vicinity of State Hospital Drive, US-11, Clinic Road, and Toby Run Road (hereinafter collectively referred to as the Borough Farm), as shown in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, portions of the Borough Farm are operated under special restrictions because of, but not limited to, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania-imposed deed restrictions, sewage sludge biosolids applications and related Department of Environmental Protection regulations, farmer lease operations, and hunting access; and

WHEREAS, the Borough must meet its various obligations regarding stewardship and management of the Borough Farm and protection of the general welfare of Borough residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Montour Area Recreation Commission (hereinafter MARC), a Pennsylvania Domestic Nonprofit Corporation (15 Pa C.S. § 5306) operating as a multi-governmental organization in Montour County, Pennsylvania as authorized by an Intergovernmental Agreement of Cooperation, dated 13 May, 2020, has used and wishes to continue to use certain lands and structures within the Borough Farm for public recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is a member of MARC and wishes to promote public recreation where appropriate; and

MARC Danville Borough Farm Land/Facility Use MOU

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WHEREAS, MARC and the Borough wish to enter into an Agreement for allowance of limited public recreational use of portions of the Borough Farm, subject to the conditions and restrictions set forth herein, while retaining the Borough's authority to operate and maintain the Borough Farm for other agricultural-related purposes, to include, but not limited to, agriculture, forestry, wildlife management, and other related uses;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, and intending to be legally bound, the Participants agree as follows:

- 1. MARC shall continue to be permitted to use the structure know as the "pig barn", shown on Exhibit A, for storage of materials and as the starting/finishing location of the Humdinger Trail Runs, held annually on the first Saturday of March. MARC shall maintain locks on all building doors to prevent unauthorized entry to the building and shall provide copies of keys to the Borough. MARC shall not store flammable liquids or other hazardous materials inside the building except as needed for heating and food preparation on the first Saturday of March. MARC shall remove all exterior race amenities from the building grounds by the second Saturday of March. MARC employees and supervised volunteers shall be permitted to access the pig barn at any time during the year, via the access route shown on Exhibit A, so long as entry does not conflict with Borough employee or farmer activities which may be taking place on adjacent fields.
- 2. In the event the Borough wishes to store materials in the pig barn, the Borough shall provide five (5) days notice to MARC to allow MARC to move materials as needed. In the event the Borough needs to store substantial quantities of materials in the pig barn to the point where it is no longer feasible for MARC to also store materials there, the Borough shall provide thirty (30) days notice to MARC to remove its materials. A termination of MARC's ability to use the pig barn for material storage shall not terminate the other provisions of this Agreement.
- 3. MARC shall be permitted to use the Borough Farm field access roads, field edge areas, and nearby wooded stream corridor, shown on Exhibit A, as part of the Humdinger Trail Runs only on the first Saturday of March each year, except that MARC staff and supervised volunteers may enter these locations from January 1 through the first Saturday of March when needed to prepare the race course. MARC shall make conspicuous note on its websites, Facebook page, printed materials, and any other advertisements that these farm field access roads, field edge areas, and wooded stream corridor are closed to public use at all other times during the year except as may be authorized by the Borough.

MARC Danville Borough Farm Land/Facility Use MOU

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- MARC shall not enter, nor permit its volunteers, racers, or other event attendees to enter the Borough maintenance building site and adjacent parking lot or lawns, shown on Exhibit A.
- MARC shall not enter, nor permit its volunteers, racers, or other event attendees to enter the tillable farmlands, shown on Exhibit A.
- 6. MARC shall be permitted to construct and maintain hiking and mountain biking trails (hereinafter Trails) on the forested portion of the Borough Farm lands as depicted on Exhibit A. Parking and trail access shall be provided by MARC through the adjacent Montour County owned Hopewell Park, as depicted on Exhibit A. MARC shall be solely responsible for the stewardship of these Trails and shall be permitted to provide trailhead mapping and non-permanent trail blazes along these Trails. MARC shall be responsible for any permitting necessary for trail construction. MARC shall provide notice to the Borough of any planned trail construction or maintenance activities. MARC shall make every effort to avoid construction or trail maintenance activities during the hunting seasons designated in Section 7 8 below.
- 7. MARC shall be permitted to investigate and construct a new trail paralleling the US-11 road corridor, as depicted on Exhibit A, to connect the Danville Area School District campus and planned athletic fields with Hopewell Park and existing Trails. MARC shall be required to coordinate with the Borough on trail location, design, and maintenance and to secure all permitting and permissions as may be required. The Borough makes no guarantee, implied or explicit, of MARC's ability to secure the required permits and permissions and it shall be understood by both the Borough and MARC that this agreement in no way obligates the Danville Area School District or any other parties to allow such trail construction. It shall be MARC's obligation to secure any and all approvals that may be required.
- 8. In order to avoid conflicts with hunters who have been awarded hunting permits by the Borough to hunt on the Borough Farm, MARC shall post notices at the parking area and trailheads that these Trails are closed to all users except those hunters with valid Borough hunting permits during the following periods:
 - Saturdays during the spring gobbler season (typically the last Saturday of April through the last Saturday of May, as determined annually by the PA Game Commission)
 - Saturdays during archery season (typically the last Saturday of September or the first Saturday of October through late November, as determined annually by the PA Game Commission)

MARC Danville Borough Farm Land/Facility Use MOU

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- All days during the antlerless deer muzzleloader season (typically a one-week period in mid-October, as determined annually by the PA Game Commission)
- d. All days during the regular firearms antlerless and antlered deer seasons (typically the last Saturday of November through the second Saturday of December, as determined annually by the PA Game Commission)
- e. Those Sundays, during any of the aforementioned time periods, when hunting is allowed by the PA Game Commission
- 9. MARC shall be permitted to conduct special events on these Trails during the year except during the periods of time designated in Section 7 8 above. MARC shall notify the Borough at least thirty (30) days before any special event it intends to conduct. Any special event must comply with the terms of this Agreement.
- 10. If it is discovered that trail users are entering tillable farmlands or other prohibited portions of the Borough Farm, MARC shall, at its sole expense, post barriers and notices to prevent continued violations of this Agreement. Should MARC's corrective actions fail to end violations of this Agreement, the Borough may order MARC to close the Trails for a period of time to be determined by the Borough.
- 11. In order to facilitate emergency vehicle access to remote sections of trail, MARC shall be permitted to clear and maintain the former access road from Toby Run Road to the top of the hillside, as depicted on Exhibit A, subject to the following conditions:
 - a. MARC shall secure any required erosion and sedimentation control permitting.
 - MARC shall ensure that proper erosion controls are maintained to protect
 Borough lands and adjacent Mahoning Township roadways.
 - c. MARC shall ensure that the existing gate remains closed and locked at all times, except while maintenance work is being conducted, and a copy of the gate lock key shall be provided to the Borough.
 - d. No motorized vehicles shall be permitted to use this road, except as may be needed in case of emergency or during times of road maintenance, trail construction, special events, or maintenance operations where motorized equipment is necessary. MARC shall provide to the Borough at least five (5) business days prior notice of any planned work events fitting this criteria.
- 12. No camping shall be permitted on the property.
- 13. MARC shall not be permitted to use herbicides on the property unless specifically requested by MARC at least five (5) business days in advance and approved by the Borough. If approved, any herbicide use must be done by a licensed applicator.

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- 14. MARC shall provide to the Borough proof of General Liability Insurance in the amount of \$10,000,000, provided through the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Risk Management Association, naming the Borough as an additional insured party, and shall continue such coverage at all times during the duration of this Agreement.
- 15. This Agreement shall be valid for five (5) years from its effective date and shall be renewable in five (5) year increments if so agreed by both the Borough and MARC.
- 16. The terms of this Agreement shall not be modified except through written agreement of both the Borough and MARC.
- 17. This Agreement shall not be terminated before the agreed expiration date unless one or more Participant violates the terms of this Agreement or unless otherwise agreed by both Participants a 60-day written notice is provided by either Participant to the other.

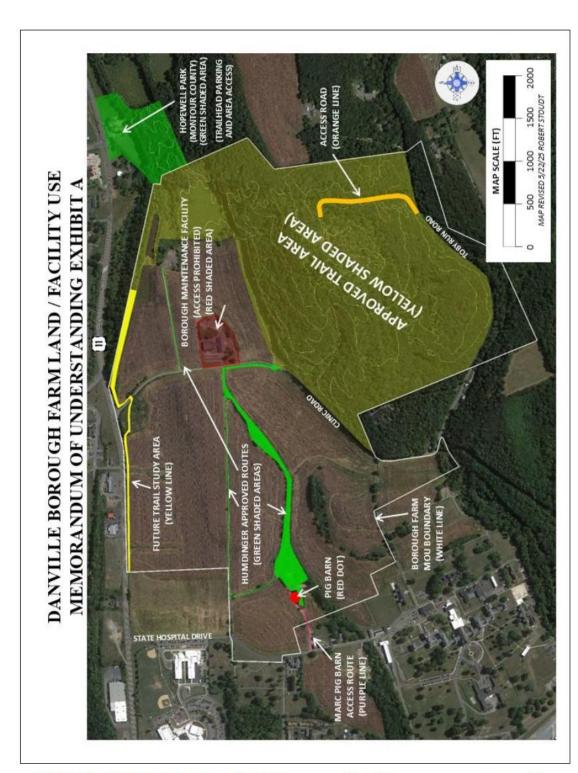

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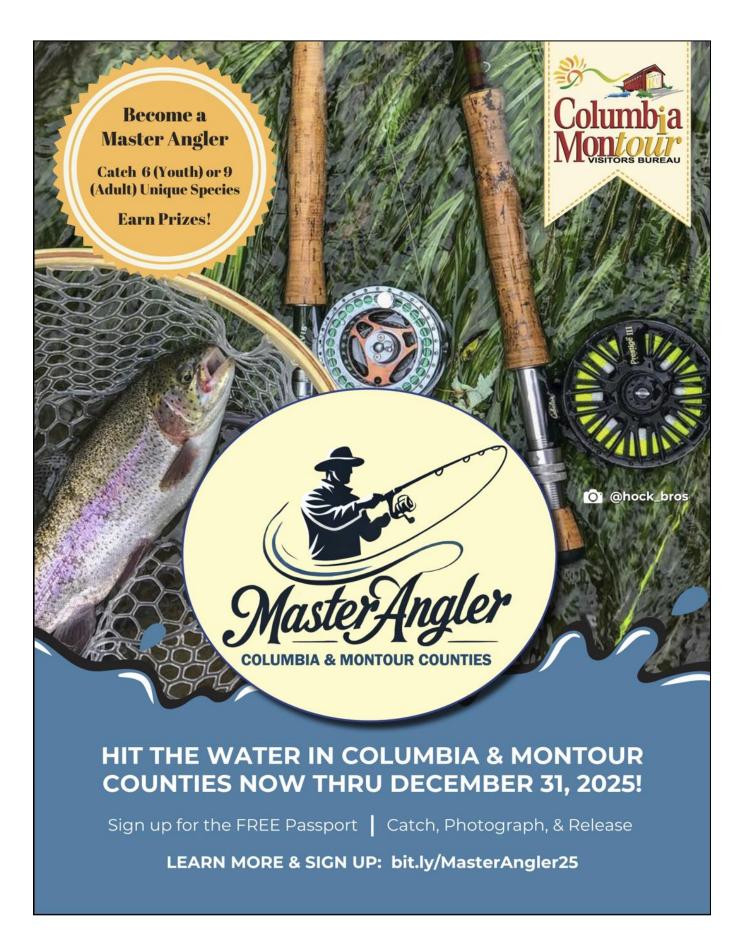
